THE MOTIVE IN MAKING DISCIPLES

Story: John 21:1-19

Devotion:

Jesus found the disciples back to fishing.

He asked Peter the same question three times, "Do you love me?"

Jesus wanted Peter to understand that loving Him was what he needed to feed the sheep.

Main Idea: Loving God is the foundation for loving others.

Reflection Questions:

1. What's your motivation for loving others?
2. How will you cultivate your love for God so that you can love others more?

Prayer:

"Lord, help me to love you deeper so I can love others better. Amen."

JULY 21

REACHING OUT TO THE UNLOVABLE

Story: John 13:12–15 (Jesus Washes Feet)

Devotion:

Jesus led by example—serving humbly. Discipleship is lived, not just taught.

Main Idea: We lead others by example.

Reflection Questions:

1. How can you serve others better?
2. Whom and where can you serve?

Prayer:

“Lord, make me a servant leader. Amen.”

JULY 22

MULTIPLYING FAITH

Story: Acts 16:11–15 (Lydia)

Devotion:

Lydia encountered God—and her whole household followed.

Faith multiplies when shared.

Main Idea: One transformed life can impact many.

Reflection Questions:

1. How has God changed your life?
2. Who can you influence?

Prayer:

“Lord, use my life to impact others.
Amen.

JULY 23

GUIDING THE NEXT GENERATION

Story: 1 Samuel 3:1–10 (Samuel & Eli)

Devotion:

Eli guided Samuel to recognize God's voice.

The next generation needs guidance.

Main Idea: We help others hear and follow God.

Reflection Questions:

1. Who are you discipling?
2. How are you guiding them?

Prayer:

"Lord, help me invest in the next generation. Amen."

JULY 24

FINISHING WELL

Story: 2 Timothy 4:6–8 (Paul's Final Words)

Devotion:

Paul finished strong—faithful until the end.

Legacy is built through perseverance.

Main Idea: A faithful life leaves a lasting legacy.

Reflection Questions:

1. What legacy do you want to leave?
2. What must you do today to finish well?

Prayer:

“Lord, help me remain faithful until the end. Amen.”
